Event Information:

The 2014 OTU Devonport Oceania Triathlon Championships is the annual Trans Tasman Teams Challenge. The event will be conducted as a standard ITU Junior Sprint Distance Race, however, each State/NTA region and New Zealand will nominate athletes to make up their “National/State Team” and a team point score will be conducted to determine champion Trans Tasman male and female teams.

Teams will consist of:

- Four (4) athletes for the male race
- three (3) athletes for the female race

Each state and NZL may enter more than one team, but must nominate the members of their team by the race briefing the day before the event (Friday 28 February).

Additional State Teams will be named “A”, “B”, “C” etc.

Points will be allocated as per an athlete’s placing – so 1 point for first place, 2 points for second, etc. The team with the **lowest score** will win the Trans Tasman Team Trophy. In the case that two teams tie in points, the winner will be the team with the highest individual placing.

Athletes will still race individually to win the OTU Oceania Junior Championships, but will also contribute to their nominated team’s points. Athletes whose state/NTA region does not have the numbers to field a full team, may still race. We will do our best to make sure every athlete is in a team – composite teams will be formed with athletes not in their State team.

This is a very popular part of the SCODY Australian Junior Triathlon Series, with great team spirit and an individual emphasis!

Perpetual trophies will be awarded to the winning teams.
